VFU/O **AUSTRALIA SPECIALISED DECIMAL TO 1995:** The substantially complete collection is in two well filled new springback binders on well annotated quadriple pages. **VOLUME 1** ranging from QEII coils (no QEII definitives) to 1979 Australia Day duplicated array of shades, papers, UV reactions and constant varieties and colour shifts. There are no 1971 Xmas blocks but there is a page of duplicated cream and white paper singles (23) with at least 10 duplicated ACSC varieties (CV \$167). This volume includes separate studies of the 40¢, 50¢ and \$1 Navigator inc. UV reactions inc. ACSC varieties also noting 4 x Perf 15x14 SG 401c F-VFU, 1969 First Flight study inc. varieties, \$2 Gum Trees study inc. constant varieties, the best being Fungus Flaw BW 665e (\$30). Also included 1970 Cook M/S and 1968 Soil-Medical gutter pairs both thick and thin formats. ACSC and McCleary listed varieties are generously spread thought the range of issues, the best item being 1972 7c Olympics Rowing BW 602d (\$100). **The duplicated array of ACSC varieties throughout the range has a 2002 cat value of at least \$1700 alone** (1400+, 4 MS). **VOLUME 2** 1978 Birds to 1998 Xmas all VFU or CTO inc. all s/t strips pairs and blocks, lots of peel and stick wild life roll issues in a range of koala printings and formats, booklets in various printings and a range of M/S and booklets with Philatelic Exhibition Overprints. At the back, a Hagner and glassines with 1999 issues. A quality assembly of considerable value (1300+, 23 MS, 29 Booklets). Overall, this a very valuable collection with the estimate being a paltry 26% of the cat value of the ACSC listed varieties in volume 1 alone (2700+, 26MS, 29 Booklets) ..... 450

2. O **AUSTRALIA DECIMALS ON AND OFF PAPER, QUANTITY: Off-paper stamps:** - a huge quantity off-paper sorted by individual stamp into several hundred plastic bank bags in a plastic grocery bag. The majority are domestic postage rate ranging from 20¢ to 45¢. The 20¢ rate started in 1978 and the 45¢ rate finished in 2002. The weight is 2.1 kg. **On-paper stamps:** - a similar range as above but to the 50¢ rate (this rate started in 2003), all unsorted. Some higher values and some lower values are

present, but the majority is in the range stated in 3 plastic grocery bags, weight 3.9kg. Also 85gm of world off-paper inc. Australian Territories is thrown in. The total weight is around 6kg. The 4 bags are in a cardboard box with total weight 6.6kg (many '000's) ..... 70




